## Welcome to Woodland Springs Touring Park

Please take a moment to read our park rules. A full list of terms and conditions is provided on our website.

### Adults Only

Please note that our strict adult only policy also applies to visitors of guests.

### Day visitors

If guests are expecting visitors, please let reception know in advance. All visitors are required to call at reception on arrival and to leave their car in the entrance car park. Visitors are subject to a small additional charge which is clearly displayed in reception.

### Dogs

Must be kept on a lead at all times unless using the dedicated dog exercise area. Please make every effort to ensure your dog does not disturb other park users. Please clean up after your dog and use the bins provided.

### Noise Levels

Woodland Springs intends to provide a peaceful environment for people to relax. Please be considerate to others and ensure that noise is kept to a reasonable level.

### Campfires/BBQs

Due to the presence nearby of thatched cottages, open fires are strictly prohibited. You are welcome to use BBQ but in order to avoid damaging the grass, we would ask that these are raised off the ground. Please also take great care of disposing of any charcoal as this can remain a fire hazard for many hours after use. BBQ's and other forms of cooking are not permitted in our pods.

### Cars

Please observe the one way system and the 5mph speed limit and give way to pedestrians at all times. In order to keep traffic to a minimum, only one car per pitch is permitted. If you have a second car, this should be left in the entrance car park at all times. No lorries or commercial vehicles are allowed on the park.

Parking or awnings are not permitted on grass at any time.

To avoid disturbance to other guests, you are not permitted to drive onto the park between 11pm and 7am. For access between these hours, please park in the entrance car park and walk to your pitch.

### Pitches

Please ensure that your pitch is kept tidy and free of rubbish. We would ask that only breathable groundsheets are used on grass and we will ask you to remove any solid groundsheets, tarpaulins, plastic etc if we see these in use on grass. Please respect the planting and vegetation around your pitch and avoid doing anything which may cause damage.

### Rubbish/Recycling

We try and encourage as much recycling as possible. Glass should be placed in the clearly marked black bins. All other waste including recycling/non recycling and food waste should be placed in the blue bins. Waste is hand sorted locally after collection. Large items and electrical items are not accepted. Dog waste must be left in the dedicated bins provided.
